WELCOME TO McDONALD OBSERVATORY

Open to the public daily, McDonald Observatory is one of the major astronomical research facilities in the world. The Frank N. Bash Visitors Center offers a unique astronomical experience, insight into the workings of this scientific facility, and a variety of public programs.

CHECK-IN POINT: VISITORS CENTER

The Visitors Center is open from 10 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. daily (except Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Days). Extensive exhibits explain what astronomers do at the Observatory. The Center also includes a theater, Gift Shop, and the StarDate Café.

DAYTIME PASS

(INCLUDES SOLAR VIEWING AND GUIDED TOUR)

Explore the "Decoding Starlight" exhibit at the Visitors Center and enjoy various astronomical presentations in our multimedia theater.

The Solar Viewing program includes interactive telescope views of sunspots, flares, and more in our theater. (45 mins)

The 90-minute guided tour features one of the Observatory's large research telescopes and spectacular hundred-mile mountain vistas. Recreational vehicle access is limited, and shuttle service is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Enjoy night sky tours and views of celestial objects through telescopes at the Visitors Center and guided interpretation of astronomical topics. When weather prevents telescope viewing, a special astronomy program is provided; refunds are not available. No reservations are required or accepted for Star Parties. **Dress warmly at all times of the year.** The StarDate Café and Gift Shop open one hour before the Star Party.
